

Rear Transport Cover Installation Tips

Here are some tips to properly maintain your Rear Transport Cover and give it a long life. RTC's need to fit snug and flapping should be avoided. These tips will help with overcome the differing shapes and sizes in frames.

Once you have your RTC on the bikes and zipped up, you want to make sure you have the cover tightened as much as possible. Be sure to tighten the 1" wide straps over the top first as shown in figure A. These should be checked every once in a while during your drive. After these straps are tight and snug, pull the shock cords on both ends tight and slide the spring loaded tighteners up as tightly as possible. Tie a loop knot up against the spring loaded tightener to prevent the tightener from loosening during the drive as shown in figures B & C. Tuck the excess shock cord in to prevent it from flapping in the wind (figure D).
